

This is the first year running that we have carried the new-style Residents Perception Survey, which is required by the Regulator of Social Housing (RSH). The questions were agreed in 2022/2023 following consultation with Social Housing providers across the country. The title 'perception' is important to remember, and in a small organisation with low numbers participating in the survey even one or two answers can sway the results.

The survey is the same for all, meaning whether you have 38 properties or 38,000 the questions are fixed. This sometimes makes some questions seem irrelevant, for example how we interact with the neighbourhood. This has more relevance when you are looking at a housing estate of 200 homes, all managed by the same housing association, however the equality allows for direct comparison between all providers.

The survey allows us to see our successes and gives us the opportunity for any improvements in our service if necessary.

Overall we are seen to be providing an excellent service, with no areas that require any major changes.

It should be noted that only 3 complaints were made but it is noted that more work needs to be done in this area.


This year 28 of the 38 households responded.































Comments from the Survey
